

A "yes" answer to any of these questions, may indicate that a child has learning differences and may need help to retrain their auditory, visual and sensory-motor skills.

Questionnaire

- Y N 1. My child has difficulty remembering left from right.
- Y N 2. My child does not understand how the directions of North and South on a map relate to the world.
- Y N 3. My child is not very coordinated or good at sports.
- Y N 4. My child has difficulty throwing a ball into an intended receptacle, such as a basketball into the goal or a paper wad into the garbage can.
- Y N 5. My child has trouble jumping rope.
- Y N 6. My child does not seem to hear me when I call but his/her hearing is fine.
- Y N 7. My child seems to wiggle and to move all the time and is unable to sit still.
- Y N 8. My child touches everything of interest.
- Y N 9. My child seems to get confused when asked to follow simple directions.
- Y N 10. My child has trouble with handwriting.
- Y N 11. My child is forgetful, unorganized and sometimes confused over what is expected of him/her.
- Y N 12. My child has difficulty remembering more than one verbal request at a time.
- Y N 13. My child describes things using "tactile" words such as, "That doesn't feel good" and "You hurt my feelings."
- Y N 14. My child is sensitive about how things feel -- complains that clothing is too scratchy, or stiff and hurts.
- Y N 15. My child has difficulty understanding cause and effect and does not seem to understand simple consequences to specific actions.
